Your rights

Remember, **you have rights** regarding your personal data.

- You have the right to be informed about the collection and use of your personal data
- You have the right to withdraw your consent which allows us to collect, store and process your personal data
- You have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- You have the right to ask us to erase your data.
- You have the right to know if your personal data is being shared with anyone other than the person to whom you have given your personal data

- You have the right to restrict us processing your personal data
- You have the right to object and complain
- You have the right to know if we are collecting personal data on you for the purposes of profiling you.

What personal information we are collecting about you

We are collecting the following information for the purpose of communicating with staff and/or trustees of charitable trusts and foundations; to personalise our communications with them; and to process any donations they make:

- Name
- Address
- Phone
- Email
- DOB
- Job Title (if relevant)
- Organisation (of relevant)
- Bank details for processing of payments
- Details for Gift Aid
- Worth/Income
- Interests
- Details about your past charitable engagement
- Details about your past business engagement
- Any other personal or accessibility requirements to you may have to ensure that you are able to participate safely and comfortably at any Events to which we may invite you.

Who will we share your personal data with

It is extremely rare that we ever will share your personal details outside of the Coram Group of Charities. Usually the fundraising team only share information with our finance department in order to process your generous donations, payments or other fees.

How we are collecting your personal information

With your consent, we will collect personal information from you which will be stored on our secure servers.

We may have also collected your name, contact details, etc. from private and/or professional associates who are known to you, publicity that is available to the public or from public sources such as the internet or other “official” information sources (e.g. Charity Commission, Companies House, land registry, etc.)

Our lawful basis for collecting and processing your personal data

In most cases, you will have actively provided your personal details and consented to the use of your personal details over the phone.

We have legitimate interest for collecting and processing your personal information due to your past charitable/business engagement. Or you have directly consented to supporting Coram and/or the Coram Group of Charities in this way.

Retention of your personal information

We will hold your information for a maximum time of 6 years at which time we will either;

- contact you again to renew consent and ensure your personal information is up to date in our records,
- or automatically erase your data
